

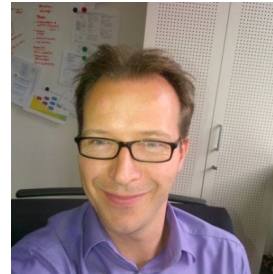

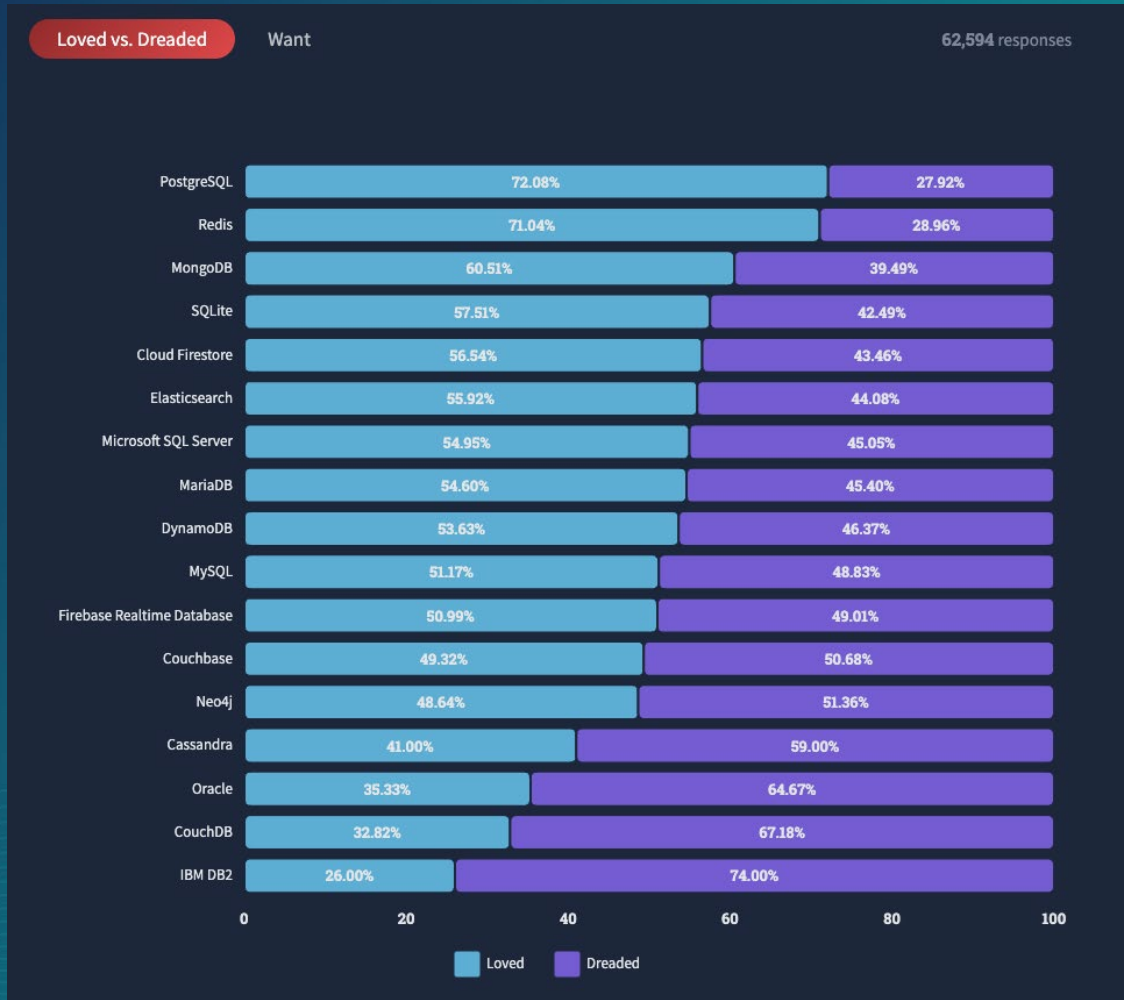

POSTGRES: **MOST LOVED** DATABASE



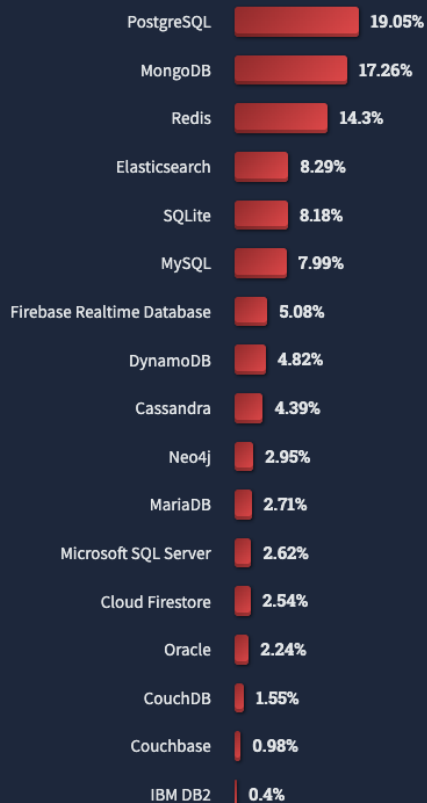
2022 STACK OVERFLOW DEVELOPERS SURVEY:

Loved vs. Dreaded

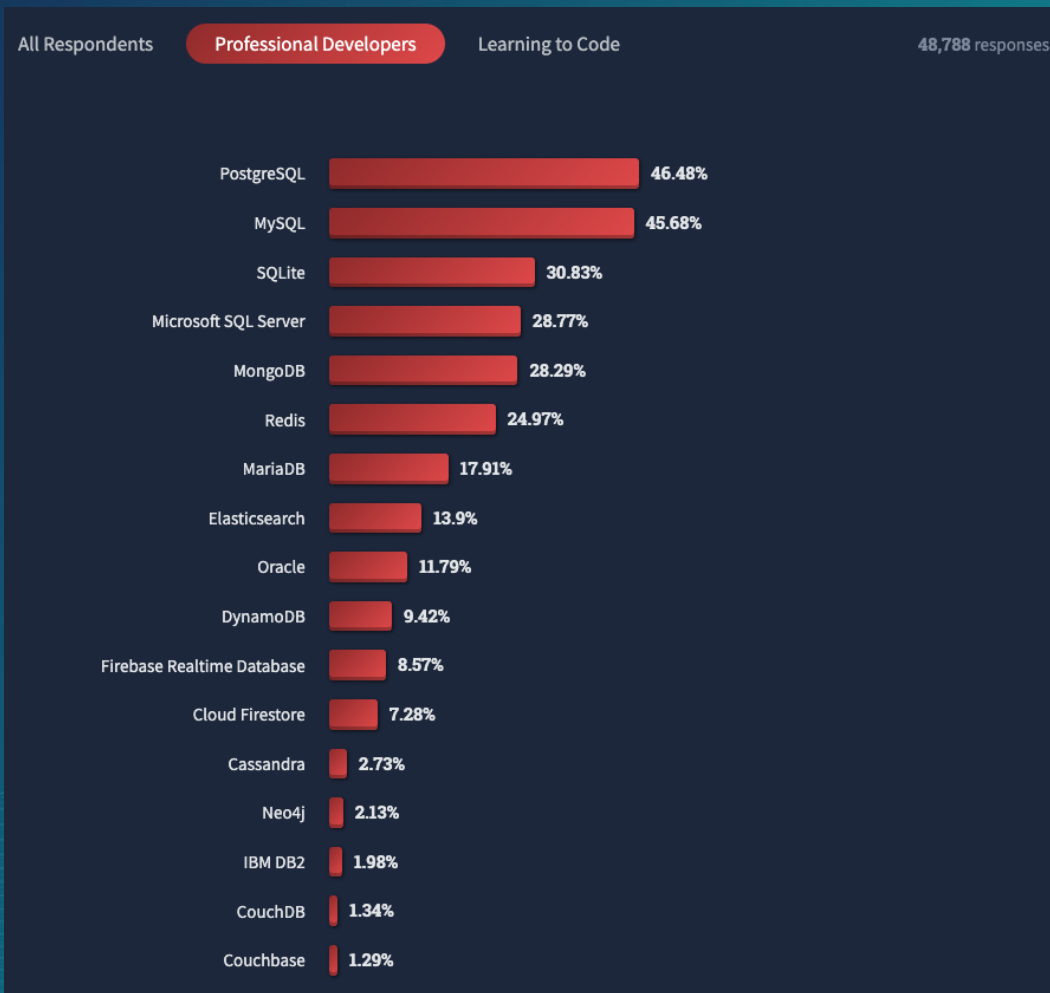

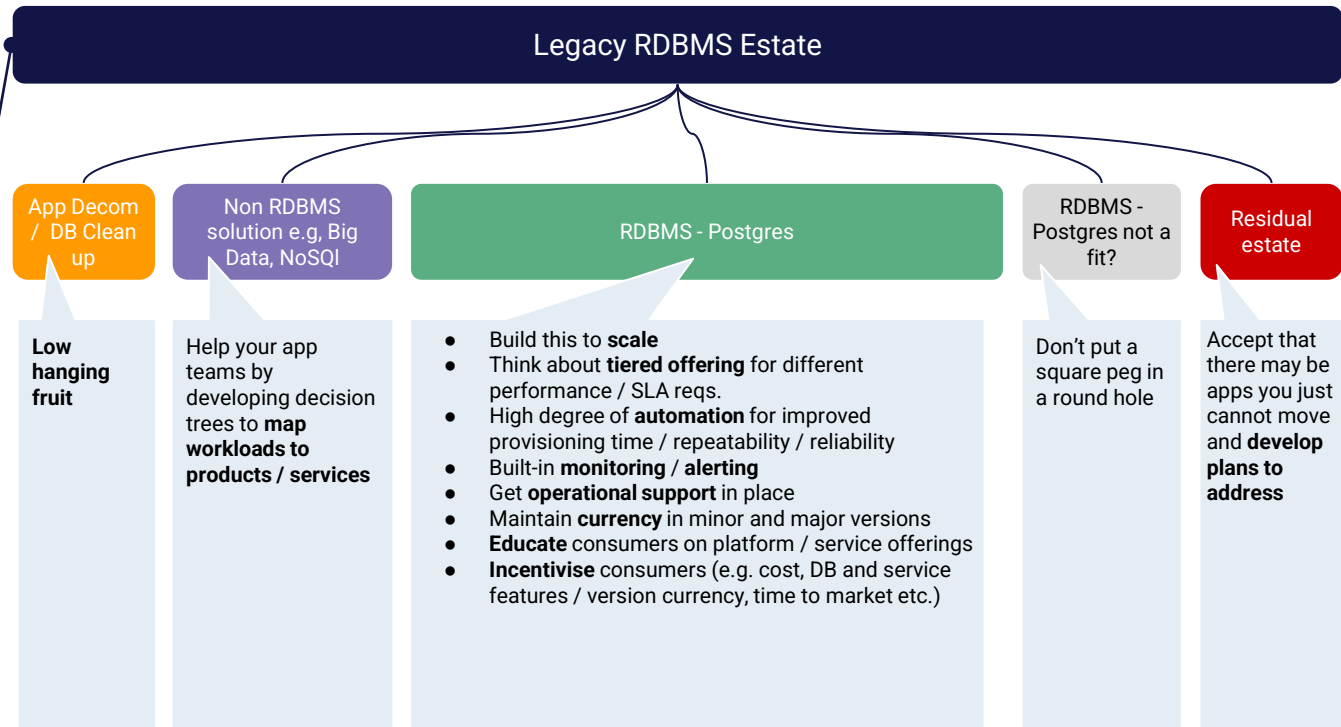

ORACLE MIGRATION: MULTIPLE PATHS

- There are **many options** to reduce / exit legacy database estate.
- Our experience is that there is value in customers (**upfront investing time** to evaluate
- Understand which are **applicable** to you
- Determine **readiness** of target platforms



ORACLE MIGRATION: MOBILIZING

You know **what** you want to do, you know **where** you want to go, now the question is...**HOW?**

- Reality is the technical migration activities are only a fraction of the work involved.
- Key challenges to overcome:
 - Getting **buy-in** with application teams
 - Demonstrating the **business case**
 - Getting into application teams release cycles and maintaining their **commitment** to see this through
 - Having the **support** to react to the technical challenges that will arise
